3-Heights™ Windows NT Services

July 13, 2005 - PDF Tool AG is pleased to announce the availability of their 3-Heights™ PDF Tools in Windows NT Service versions. The Windows NT Services automatically process files in watched folders. Several watched folders can be configured, and different conversion options can be selected for each of the folders.

The following tools are now available and can be evaluated and ordered:

The services can be used, for example, to:

- configure folders for different printers and page sizes. Moving a PDF file into a folder automatically prints it on the specified printer, using the predefined page size.
- create folders for converting PDF files into image files. Folders are defined for each image format, and each folder can be configured with conversion options (e.g. resolution, compression, dimensions). Moving a PDF into a folder automatically converts the PDF file to that image type, applying the predefined options.
- create folders for converting images files into PDF. Folders can be configured with different conversion options (e.g. resolution, dimensions, protection). Moving an image file into a folder automatically converts it to PDF, applying the predefined options.

The next Windows NT Service products that will be released will include the 3-Heights™ PDF Optimizer Service and the 3-Heights™ PDF Security Service.

3-Heights™ PDF Optimizer Service

The **3-Heights™ PDF Optimizer Service** will allow you to, for example:

- Configure folders for different optimization processes (e.g. fast web viewing, high quality printing). Copying a PDF file into a folder will optimize it for that process according to the predefined options.

- Configure several folders with different optimization options. Copying a PDF into each of the folders will let you quickly determine the best optimization configuration for that PDF file.

3-Heights™ PDF Security Service

With the **3-Heights™ PDF Security Service** you will be able to, for example:

- Configure folders with different document permissions (allow printing, allow copying etc). Copying a PDF file into a folder will automatically apply the predefined document permissions to that file.
- Configure several folders with different user and / or owner passwords. Copy a PDF file into a folder will automatically protect the file with the predefined passwords for that folder.

The 3-Heights™ PDF Optimizer Service and the 3-Heights™ PDF Security Service are scheduled for release in the early fall, 2005.

Windows NT Service versions for all 3-Heights™ PDF tools will be ready by the end of 2005.

It may astound you, but many PDF creators systematically produce corrupt PDF files, i.e. every PDF file they create is corrupt.
